Happy Holidays to each of you. And, please ask one of us for help if you're not seeing all our communications.



**Main Line Ski Club now offers all members 24/7 access to view or download your dynamic membership card via our website.**



### How do I access my card?

You can generate a dynamic member card as many times as needed, such as every-time you use the card. Or, you can save the card or print for future use.

#### From a desktop computer or 'desktop view'

- 1 - From the top right corner of your screen, **log in** to our website using your member ID & password
  - 2 - Your name will appear at the top right corner of your screen
  - 3 - Select the black arrow next to your name, creating a pull down menu
  - 4 - Select **'Profile'** from that menu
  - 5 - The top box displayed is titled 'Membership Summary'
  - 6 - Inside the Membership Summary box is a link, **click on 'Download Membership Card'**
- On a desktop, your card will download as a PDF document.

#### From your cell phone or tablet or 'mobile view'

- 1 - Select 'Log In' at the bottom menu on your screen (key icon)
  - 2 - **Log in** using your member ID & Password
  - 3 - Select **'Your Info'** from that same menu on the bottom (person icon)
  - 4 - Select **'Profile'** on the menu that pops up
  - 5 - The top box displayed is titled 'Membership Summary'
  - 6 - Inside the Membership Summary box is a link, **click on 'Download Membership Card'**
- On Mobile View, your card will appear on your screen. You should have an option to 'save image' or 'print' or 'save on files.' Or, you can take a 'screen shot' and save it in your pictures. These options are specific to the device you are using.

**6:30-6:45 a.m. PA Stop and Go Pickup** at the I-476/76 Interchange. Exit 16 Conshohocken (PA 23) Park-n-Ride 900 Matsonford Rd. West Conshohocken, PA. Please notify leader if using this pick-up.

Note: The bus will not wait for late attendees!!!

Returning: Approximately 3 hours after Elk Mt departure at 5:00 p.m.

Cost includes: lift ticket, Perkiomen Motorcoach transportation, bus driver tip, subs, chips, snacks, water and soft drinks; free Wi-Fi on bus; electrical outlets at seats, Happy hour at 4:00 p.m. with beer and wine.
