

## Main Line Ski Club Racing Team Repeats as Eastern Pennsylvania Ski Council Cup and Master's Champions

The 2020 Eastern Pennsylvania Ski Council Cup Race was held on Sunday, March 8<sup>th</sup> at Blue Mountain. On a beautiful day, the race attracted 50 racers representing six of the Council's member clubs. Main Line Ski Club had three teams composed of a total of 19 racers on the hill ranging in age from 22-77. The Master's team is a team comprised of racers age 60 or over, while the team's competing for the Council Cup can be of any age.

Main Line's participants in the Master's category were as follows:

Main Line's Master's team, which is composed of the fastest four men and two women included Dave, Tad, Ron, Greg, Pam and Janet. Main Line's total team time of 246.93 seconds snuck by the Mack Ski Club's Master's team by the extremely close margin of 2.36 seconds to win the Master's race. While most of the Main Line masters were veteran ski racers, Janet Schmidt ran her first ever race to help support a great outcome and help take home the Master's trophy for another year.

For individual awards in the Master's category, Rob Allison from the Mack Ski Club won the coveted "Cressman Cup", in honor of the late Frank Cressman, for his 26.82 fastest single run. Main Line's Tad VanZoeren (27.57) and Dave DeCampli (27.78) were second and third in the Cressman Cup challenge. The top Master's woman was Sarah Harvey from the Mack Ski Club with a single run time of 31.81. Main Line's Pam DeCampli was second with a time of 36.55.

Main Line's "A" team, which is composed of the fastest four men and two women included Casey, Tom, Jason, Ted, Kelly and Stacy. The "A" team crushed the rest of the field with a winning team time of 210.84 seconds to take home the coveted "Council Cup" for another year. Flying Dutchmen Ski Club was the second-place team with a team time of 242.96 seconds while Main Line's "B" team came in third with a team time of 254.16 seconds. Of special note, Zach Keller ran his first ever race to support Main Line's "B" team result.

For individual awards, Main Line's Kelly Flack was awarded the fastest women on the hill with two blistering race times of 26.04 and 26.62 seconds. Kelly was fourth overall with her combined time of 52.66 seconds. Main Line's Stacy Kearney was second with her combined time of 55.92. Joe Sulpizio from the Mack Ski Club was the fastest man on the hill with a combined time of 49.93. Main Line's Jason Smith (52.30) and Casey Wakeen (52.43) were second and third respectively.

Of historical note, Main Line has won the Council Cup 23 of the past 25 years. This result dwarfs any other run of success by a Council ski club all the way back to the early 1960's when the race was first conducted.

We look forward to building on this year's success and expand participation next year in this fun, but competitive race. The race is open to all members of clubs in the Eastern Council.
