

SPECIAL HONORS TO MLSC SKI TEAM

I had the pleasure of attending the Eastern Pennsylvania Ski Council (EPSC) Fall meeting last Sunday and am pleased to report that the Main Line Ski Team was successful in numerous categories at the 2021 EPSC Council Cup race held at Montage back on February 28th. Our name will once again be included on two of the large trophies (Masters and the "Council Cup") that are held by EPSC, and I bought back two individual awards for our team: the **2021 Shaker Cup** awarded to Main Line with 190 points, and the **2020 Frank Cressman Cup** that is dedicated to the fastest Masters racer (over 60 years of age).

Team awards for Main Line included first place in the Masters Cup with a team total time of 430.15 besting second place Mack Ski Club by a healthy margin. The Masters team was composed of Wendy Neel, Jim Neel, Tad VanZoeren, Peter Parker and Dave Wadas. Main Line also placed first in the "A" Cup, or the coveted "Council Cup" with a team total time of 363.79 seconds, again besting second place Mack Ski Club by a healthy margin. The "A" team was composed of Stacy Kearney, JB Bucha, Thomas Mecca, Dave Moore and Jonathan Diehl. Individual recognitions included Jim Neel who won the Frank Cressman Cup as the fastest male in the Masters group, Steve Babyak who won Fastest Telemarker, and Stacy Kearney who won fastest female in the "A" group.

Other Main Line members representing the team on the race hill were Brianna Gieski, Ted Lacki, Joe Pinto, Jud Berkowicz, Peter Wepplo, John Luciani, Gregory Hurchalla, Fred Wookey, Rob Milwicz, and John Carlin.

Representing our broader membership, we want to congratulate all members of our Team for these accomplishments.

Jared Walck from EPSC is pulling together final plans for the 2022 Council Cup and Race Tour. The 2022 Council Cup date has been set for Sunday, February 27th again at Montage. Everyone from our club is welcome to participate or simply be on the hill to support our ski team members.
